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#### CONTINGENCY PLAN UNDER SC/ST (POA) RULES 1995

# 1. ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF WATCHES DEPARTMENT AND THEIR OFFICERS AT DIFFERENT LEVEL

When a view to prevent atrocities on SC/STs and for the proper implementation & monitoring of the provisions of the SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989 & Rules, 1995 the role & responsibilities of various officers at different level of different departments are specified as below:-

#### (A) STATE LEVEL OFFICERS

### (1) SECRETYARY (SJ&E) TO THE GOVT. OF H.P.

The State Govt. has notified Secretary (SJ&E) to the Govt. of H.P. as Nodal Officer under Rule 0 of the SC/ST (NIA) Rule 1995. The State Officer small be coordinating the functioning of District Magistrate/Superintendents of Police, Investigating Officers, Special Public Prosecutors and shall quarterly review:-

- (i) Reports received by State Govt. under sub rule (2) & (4) of rule 4, rule 6, clause(xi) of rule 8.
- (ii) The position of cases registered under the Act, Relief measures, adequacy of immediate facilities like rationing, clothing, shelter, legal aid, traveling & daily allowance and transport facilities provided to the victims and their dependents, performance of NGOs, SC/ST Protection Cell and public servant responsible for implementing the provisions of the Act.

## (II) SECRETARY (HOME) TO THE GOVT. OF H.P.

He shall review atleast twice in a calendar year in the month of January & July:

- The position of cases registered under investigation and under trial cases in the District & Session Courts.
- In case of long pendency of cases under the Act, he shall take up the matter with the high court for speedy disposal of the cases.
- Functions performance of Protection Cell.

# (III) SECRETARY (LAW) TO THE GOVT. OF H.P.

He shall ensure that Legal Aid to the victim of atrocities may be provided through the District Level Legal Aid Committees and shall review atleast twice in a calendar year in the month of January & July legal aid

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provided to the victims of atrocities by various District Level Lega Committees.

## (IV) DIRECTOR (SOMA)

The Director, SCs, OBCs and MA has been notified as Me Secretary of State Level Vigilance & Monitoring Committee vide notific No. kalian -F(4)-14/76-6 dated 8.1.97 & 12.11.98 by the State Govt. He convene atleast 2 meetings in a calendar year in the month of January & Jareview:

- The implementation of the provision of the Act.
- \* Relief & rehabilitation facilities provided to the victims.
- Prosecution of cases under the Act
- \* Role of different officers/agencies responsible for implementing provisions of the Act.
- Various reports received by the Govt.

He shall make recessary provisions in the annual budget of department for providing relief & rehabilitation facilities to victims.

# (V) DIRECTOR GENERAL OF POLICE

The State Govt side notification No. Kalyan-F(4)-14/76 dated 18.2. constituted protection cell for SC/ST under the charge of DGP. The m functions of the cell are:

- Conducting survey of the identified areas.
- Maintaining public order and tranquility in the identified areas.
- \* Recommending the State Govt. for deployment of special police force.
- Making investigations about the probable causes leading to an offence un the Act.
- Restoring the feeling of security amongst the members of SC/ST.
- Informing the Nodal Officer about the law and order situation in identified areas.
- Making enquiries about the investigation and spot inspection conducted various officers.
- Making enquiries about action taken by the Superintendent of Police.
- Making enquiries about the willful negligence by a public servant.
- Reviewing the position of cases registered under the Act.
- Submitting a monthly report on or before 20th day of each subsequent me to Nodal Officer about the action taken/proposed to be taken.

The protection cell shall submit a monthly report on or before 20<sup>th</sup> day of each subsequent month to nodal officer i.e. Secretary (SJ&E), Secretary (Home) about the action taken/proposed to be taken in respect of cases registered under the Act.

#### (VI) DIRECTOR PROSECUTION

- He shall review atleast twice in a calendar year in the month of January & July, the performance of Special Public Prosecutors as notified vide notification no. Home © F (11)-16/89 dated 30.1.90.
- He shall also review the position of cases pending in the courts. ## (B) DISTRICT LEVEL OFFICERS

## (i) **DISTRICT MAGISTRATE**

- The District Magistrate of the district will be the overall in-charge for the implementation of SC/ST (POA) Act 1989/Rules 1995 in his district.
- With a view to prevent atrocities on SC/ST he will take all the precautionary & preventive measures as a salid of in rule 3 of the Act.
- The District Magistrate shall review atleast twice in a calendar year in the month of January & July the performance of Special Public Prosecutors and submit a report to Secretary (Home), Secretary (SJ&E), Secretary (Law) with a copy to Director (SOMA).
- The District Magistrate shall review the position of cases registered under the Act & submit a monthly report on or before 20<sup>th</sup> day of each subsequent month to Director, Prosecution/Director, SOMA. This report shall specify the action taken, proposed to be taken in respect of investigation & prosecution of each case.
- The District Magistrate or Sub-Divisional or any other Executive Magistrate as and when receives an information from any person or upon his own knowledge that an atrocity have been committed on SC/ST within his jurisdiction, he shall immediately visit the place of occurrence to assess the extent of atrocity, loss of life, loss & damage of property and submit a report to Nodal Officer i.e. Secretary (SJ&E) with a copy to Director (SOMA).

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- The District Magistrate or Sub-Divisional Magistrate or any other Execut: Magistrate authorized by him, after inspecting the place or the area shall o the spot:
  - (i) Draw a list of victims, their family members and depender entitled for relief.
  - (ii) Prepare a detailed report of the extent of atrocity loss ar damage to the property of the victims.
  - (iii) Ordc. for intensive police patrolling in the areas.
  - (iv) Take effective & necessary steps to provide protection to the witnesses and other sympathizers of victims.
  - (iv) On the basis of spot inspection report, District magistrate shall sanction the monetary relief as per norms laid down in ker 12(4).

Magistrate of the area. A copy of sanction of relief & rehabilitation facilities provided to the victims of atrocities shall also be forwarded to Special Courts, SP & SDivis.

❖ The District Level Vigilance & Monitoring Committees shall be constituted by the District Magistrate as per rule (1), (2) of rule 17.

### (II) ADDITIONAL DISTRICT MAGISTRATE

The State Govt. has notified ADMs as Special Officers vide notification no. Kalyan -F (4)-14/76 dated 8.11.96. The Special Officer shall be responsible for:

- (i) Providing immediate relief and other facilities to the victims of atrocities and initiate necessary measures to prevent or avoid re-occurrence of atrocity.
- (ii) Setting up of awareness centre and organizing workshop in identified area at district headquarter to educate the persons belonging to the SC/ST about their rights & protection available to them under Act/Rules.
- (iii) Co-ordinate with the NGO and providing necessary facilities and financial & other-type of assistance to NGOs for maintaining centers or organizing workshop.

## DISTRICT WELFARE OFFICERS

The cases of relief to the victims of atrocities will be dealt by the respective DWO. The reports received by District Magistrate under the Act from police/SDMs, the DWO shall put up the cases of relief for sanction to District Magistrate. He shall be the drawing and disbursing officers under the head of account "2225-Welfare of SC/ST/OBCs-01-Welfare of SCs-102- Economic Betterment-02(Plan)(SOON)-20-Other Charges". The amount of relief shall be disbursed through SDM/Executive Magistrate. He will be responsible for keeping all the

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records pertaining to the relief drawn/disbursed in the district. He shall submit a annual report to the Director (SOMA) through District Magistrate on the prescribed format regarding relief sanctioned, disbursed etc. to the victims of atrocities as per Annexure-1.

(ii) He shall be the Member Secretary of the District Level Vigilance & Monitoring Committee constituted under the chairmanship of District Magistrate at district level. He will ensure that quarterly meeting of the committee is convened and all other matters concerning Act & Rules are monitored in the meeting.

He shall hold awareness camps/workshops to the propagation of Act &

#### (IV) SPECIAL PUBLIC PROSECUTORS

- The Special Public Prosecutors notified vide notification no. Home OF (11)-16/89 dated 30.1.90. He shall be responsible for conficulty increases in District & Secribic Courts amust the Act.
- On the conclusion of trial in the cases under the Act, he shall report the District Magistrate alongwith copy of judgement so that the balance amount of relief may provided to the victim of atrocity.

### (IV) SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE

- 4 He shall take all preventive & precautionary measures as prescribed in rule 3.12. He shall monitor the working of Investigating Officers & ensure that investigations under the cases registered may be completed by the lavestigating Officers within 30 days from the registration of case.
- \* He shall ensure that every information relating to the commission of an offence under the Act is registered in police station under his jurisdiction and procedure is followed by their respective SHOs as laid down in rule 5.
- ❖ He shall send monthly reports of cases registered and investigation under the Act alongwith copy of F.I.R. to the Superintendent of Police.

#### (V) <u>STATION HOUSE OFFICER</u>

- The Police Officer in charge of police station shall ensure that any information given to an officer in charge of police station orally or in writing with regard to the atrocity committed on SC/ST, shall be entered in a book being maintained by that police station.
- A copy of information so recorded shall be given forthwith, free of cost to informant.
- After the entry of F.I.R., the in charge of the police station shall inform his immediate superior forthwith.

# (C) ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF RURAL/UNBAN/LOCAL BOIDIES/NGOS

- The members of PRIs shall extend their full co-operation dur investigation of the case of atrocity committed in their area Investigating Officer.

In case of atrocity on SC/ST in their area, the member of P play non particular role in creating tension free atmosphere.

NO. CONTRACTOR AND SERVICE STATE OF SERVICE SE

The NGOs shall organize workshop/camps for creating awareness an masses with regard to the provision of the Act/Rules. For organizi camps they can formulate project proposals & submit to Ministry c Justice & Empowerment, Government of India through Director (SOM the scheme Grant-in aid to Voluntary Organizations.

# PACKACES OF RELIEF MEASURES

- (i) The victim of atrocities shall be provided monetary relief a norms laid down in rule 12(4).
- (ii) In case of complete destruction/ burnt of his own house, sir hutment is to be provided by District Administration at Gov case of destruction/burnt of rented house, 4 Biswa Land provided by the District Administration and a single room hut be provided by District Admin. At Govt. cost. Electr connection shall be provided by H.P. State Electricity Board/I Public Health Deptt. on priority basis.
- (iii) In case of death of earning member of family, employmen provided to the dependent or one family member of the vic Department of Personnel.
- (iv) For the strengthening of socio-economic condition of atrocities, the victim shall be covered under the various schaplemented by H.P.SC/ST Dev. Corporation on priority bas

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
